Grading Policy

Unit Exams – There will be a unit exam at the completion of each unit which will focus on material only from that specific unit. There will be about two or three exams per quarter with a review day before each exam. There will also be an exam at the completion of each quarter that will focus on the material during that specific quarter. Unit Exams and Quarter Exams will be worth 30% of your quarter grade.

Quizzes – There will be a quiz each week (typically on Friday's) that will focus on the material that we have been covering in class that week. Each quiz will be worth at most 50 points and will be worth 40% of your quarter grade.

- * All weekly quizzes may be retaken for a higher grade. You must contact Ms. Mitchell to set up a time to retake a quiz after school. If you were absent for a weekly quiz, you must take the retake. There are **NO** retakes for Unit Exams!

Homework – There will be occasional homework assignments. You will receive 0 points for not completing, 1 point if it is half-attempted, and 2 points for complete homework. Homework is due the day after it is assigned; homework will only be accepted late for an excused absence. Homework will be worth 10% of your quarter grade.

Classwork/Projects – We will complete classwork and projects during class. These will be worth 20% of your quarter grade.

- * Your quarter grade will be calculated by adding up all of your points and dividing by the total amount of points.
